NOTICE OF REGATTA **GOLF TOURNAMENT**

Tuesday, August 31, 2010
At NEWPORT NATIONAL GOLF CLUB
Middletown, Rhode Island

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Rules of Golf (Rules). The Organizing Authority is the Storm Trysail Foundation.

2. ENTRIES (LIMITED)

Eligible players are those that can play golf. They may enter on-line via the link on the Storm Trysail Foundation website: <http://www.stormtrysailfoundation.org/> and pay the applicable **Entry Fee no later than August 15, 2010**. Late entries may be accepted until 1700 hours, Monday, August 30, 2010 with a late payment penalty of \$50, subject to availability.

3. TOURNAMENT HEADQUARTERS/ NOTICES TO COMPETITORS / CHECK-IN

Headquarters will be located at the Newport National Golf Club, Main Clubhouse. Notices to competitors will be posted on the Notice Board. Each player is requested to check-in at the Registration Desk on Tuesday, August 31, 2010 from 1130 hours to receive Tournament Instructions, Foursome Assignments, Order of Starts, social information and related items. Tournament packets will be distributed only to players that have completed entries and submitted the required entry fee.

4. CHANGES TO THE TOURNAMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the Tournament Instructions will be posted by 0700 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule will be posted by 2000 hours on the day before it will take effect.

5. SAFETY

It shall be the individual responsibility of each competitor to wear adequate personal protection when conditions warrant. This includes before, during and after the tournament. (See STC Guidelines for Harnesses and PDFs)

6. SCHEDULE -Tuesday, August 31st:

1130 hrs Rendezvous in the vicinity of Newport National Golf Club located at approximately 41° 31' 52.23" N, 71° 15'30.67"W

1230 hrs Shotgun Start

1830 hrs or immediately after completion of the tournament: Cocktails, Dinner and Awards Ceremony

7. VHF RADIO

The Regatta Committee will attempt to broadcast on **VHF Channel 74** information such as location of Beverage Carts, Cheating players, course type, range and bearing to the tee box and green, change of course, etc. Failure to broadcast this information, or failure to receive or hear these broadcasts, will not be grounds for redress.

8. COURSES

The Course is Newport National Golf Club, Middletown, Rhode Island
Players shall play 18 holes, once around. Designated tee boxes for the first hole for each foursome will be posted at registration.

The Regatta Committee may set a leeward gate. If no gate is in place, players should proceed to the next hole.

The Regatta Committee may set an offset mark at the Windward Mark. If no offset mark is in place, players should proceed to the next hole.

9. MARKS

Marks will be metallic pins with flags. The String Rule on order of mark roundings will be in effect.

10. STARTING SIGNALS

Tournament will be started on time with the first signal at 1130 hrs, prep at 1200 and starting gun at 1230. (This modifies Rule 26)

11. START LINE

The Start Line will be between a tee marker on the starboard side of the tee box and a tee marker at the port side of the tee box.

12. RECALLS

Individual recalls will be signaled for those players that do not reach the ladies tee. The Regatta Committee will attempt to notify such players on VHF Channel 74. Failure to make such transmissions, the order or timeliness of the announcements or failure of a competitor to receive or hear such transmissions shall not be grounds for redress.

13. CHANGE OF POSITION OF THE NEXT MARK

The Regatta Committee may change a mark of the course.

14. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

A competitor's cart breaking a rule may take a penalty of 2 strokes after the incident and prior to the start of the protest hearing.

15. FINISH

Will be after 18 holes are completed.

16. TIME LIMIT

The time limit will be 6 hours. Foursomes failing to finish within the time limit will be scored TLE.

17. PROTESTS

Competitors intending to protest another competitor for an incident on the course shall notify the Regatta Committee, and receive acknowledgement, as soon as possible after finishing. Completed protest forms must be submitted to the Protest Committee within 30 minutes from the time that the last foursome finished the last hole of the day. Protest hearings may be heard at Tournament Headquarters, at the discretion of the Regatta Committee.

18. SCORING

18 holes are scheduled. All 18 holes must be completed to constitute a series and championship. No holes shall be excluded.

The Low Point Scoring System will apply.

19. CLASS DESIGNATION

Foursomes will compete in one of two designated classes. Handicap or Cruising Canvas.

Those wishing to compete in the Handicap Class must submit the appropriate GHIN information (or acceptable equivalent) 48 hrs prior to start. If information is not received for a particular golfer they will play at scratch. Each player will play at 80% of their assigned individual handicap. Maximum handicap will be 24. Format will be "2 best ball" one net, one gross for each hole. The same ball cannot be scored for both.

Those in the Cruising Canvas Class will play under a "Scramble" format which will be detailed at tournament time. No handicap submission will be necessary for participation.

20. PRIZES

The STC Foundation Championship Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the foursome with the best overall performance in each class. Keeper trophies will be awarded to the top three foursomes.

21. SOCIAL

Tuesday immediately after the tournament: Awards Presentation with beverages, raffle, silent and live auctions.

22. ENTRY FEES

\$750 per Foursome , \$500 Hole Sponsor, \$1200 Hole Sponsor with Golf
