



Junior Safety-at Sea Seminar

This hands-on program presented by the Storm Trysail Foundation gives junior sailors an opportunity to learn about safety equipment and practices related to big boat sailing. The program is equally well-suited to junior sailors with and without prior big boat experience. The program includes classroom instruction, dockside demonstrations, and on-the-water practice in boats ranging from 30 to 40 feet in length. Skills to be covered include: storm preparation, crew overboard recovery, safety gear, flare use, fire suppression, crew organization and VHF radio use. Instructors have extensive heavy weather experience and have sailed tens of thousands of offshore sea miles.

Time: 0830 hrs – 1700 hrs.

Place: Raritan Yacht Club, 160 Water Street, Perth Amboy, New Jersey 08861

Who: Participants should be intermediate and advanced level sailors, ages 14-18. All juniors must be accompanied by an adult coach or supervisor.

Cost: \$40 for juniors and \$40 for adult supervisors. Price includes donuts in the morning, lunch, and end-of-day party as well as prizes, T-shirt, and take-home documents. Some scholarships may be available. Participants MUST pre-register at the web site below by July 13, 2011. Registration documents will be available around June 1. Enrollment is limited.
